I am excited about this opportunity to marry my writing, editing, and marketing skills with my passion for film.

My favorite writer is Douglas Adams. The inane bureaucracy that he brings to The Hitchhiker's Guide to the Galaxy makes comedy out of serious inequalities. He makes war feel relevant and real, for example, but also makes us laugh at ourselves even when we are led to understand the consequences of our actions. A simple towel in this story acts as both grounding reality and farce.

"What the strag (strag: non-hitch hiker) will think is that any man who can hitch the length and breadth of the galaxy, rough it, slum it, struggle against terrible odds, win through, and still knows where is towel is is clearly a man to be reckoned with."

I have extensive knowledge of film and pop culture. Watching film and television, I constantly critique the writing and think about what I might do differently. I'll ask myself, "Has someone done this? Did it work? Is it too obvious?" I have been working on various TV series and pilots over the last ten years. One of my recent projects is a four-episode arch of a Twin Peaks-esque story that takes place in the Bridgewater Triangle in Southeastern Massachusetts. For my personal research on the Bridgewater Triangle project, I spent a few nights camping in the Freetown State Forest to get a feel for the atmosphere and the surrounding area. I believe research is essential to creating a compelling script, but I also enjoy the process. To make people suspend their disbelief, the key elements of a story need to be grounded in truth and honesty. What makes Margaret Atwood's The Handmaids Tale compelling is how she tweaks the future in small progressions – her details of everyday interactions between characters are relatable so you can see the progression and regression of a society. You don't feel like you are a bystander because you recognize yourself in the characters and are horrified at the evolution.

In 2020 I returned to the University of Massachusetts in Boston to complete my degree in Professional Writing and New Media. I am currently an intern at 826 Boston, running the After-School Tutoring Program. I schedule and pair students in grades K-12 with tutors to work on writing assignments and other subjects. I perform research to maximize the potential of each session and assist tutors in brainstorming ideas, writing prompts, and creating activities to encourage students to find their voice. I enjoy working as part of a team, whether at 826, in the classroom, or with writing partners on my own scripts.
